

International Study Opportunity – Holy Land Study Tour

Proposed 2017 Program

This course of biblical archaeology fieldwork takes place at the archaeological site of Bethsaida in Israel and introduces students to elementary tenets of biblical fieldwork archaeology.

The two weeks on site at Bethsaida are supplemented by an additional week visiting selected sites in Israel, including museums and religious sites.

Students can nominate to undertake just Program I or can nominate to include Program II as well.

Program details

Dates:

Program I: 18 June - 7 July 2017 - Bible and Archaeology tour

Program II: 10 July - 14 July 2017 - Jordon Study Tour

Number of places: 25

Eligibility: Students who will be enrolled in a CSU Theology course at the time of undertaking the program

Academic Information Students may be eligible to receive academic recognition for an 8 point CSU subject [THL361 - Theology International Study Experience](#) for their participation in this program. This will require payment of a subject tuition fee, active participation in all aspects of the tour and a short paper (c. 2,000 words) describing the development of a particular locus at the site.

Program Cost:

Program I: approx AUD\$9400*

Program I and II: approx AUD\$10900

*These costs are based on the provision of the \$500 Vice Chancellor Travel Grant which is awarded to eligible undergraduate students. It is not paid directly to individuals but has already been included in program costings.

Students may also be eligible to receive financial assistance through the Australian Government's OS-HELP loan. OS-HELP can be used for a range of expenses such as airfares, accommodation, and other travel or study expenses.

Program details cont.....

Costs should include: In-country program fee, international airfares, insurance, airport transfers, accommodation (twin-share), most meals, local transport during program, and entry to all sites included in the tour itinerary.

Costs do not include: CSU Subject fee, visas, passports, immunisations (where required) additional meals/sightseeing, recreational activities, souvenirs, gratuities and incidentals.
